Self-publishing: Educational Materials in the Digital Age

This presentation will principally focus on two questions. How can teachers publish their own materials, such as textbooks or classroom materials through self-publication, especially using a platform such as Amazon KDP? How can teachers make their lectures or supplementary materials available to their students through a video-sharing platform while limiting their access by the general public?

Changes in education, student expectations, and demands for accountability are all driving the need for educators to make use of new technologies in and outside the classroom. This presentation will touch on how these demands are manifesting themselves and how teachers, or even students, can make use of these technologies.

He joined Ibaraki Christian University's Department of Contemporary English when it was founded in 2004. In addition to teaching at IC, he has also taught at University of Tsukuba and Tsukuba Gakuin University.



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
