#### Ⅰ 次の英文を読んで、問1~問3に答えなさい。

- 1. Driving in Japan, you will occasionally see signs for "Michi-no-Eki." On Japan's local highways, there are over 1,100 of these rest areas, known as "roadside stations" in English. Over 500 million people visit them yearly. They traditionally have tourist information and sell food and crafts that have been ① produced locally. However, many are turning into tourist destinations.
- 2. In 1993, local governments began to increase the number of roadside stations. While local governments ② <u>fund</u> the building of roadside stations, most of the management is left to private organizations. In the end, popular rest areas ③ <u>boost</u> local economies, and governments receive more income from taxes.
- 3. Kiso Narakawa is a roadside station that displays and sells traditional "lacquer ware\*" crafts. With its high ceiling and wood structure, the atmosphere feels more like an art gallery. It has a museum, a gift shop and a theater, and guests can learn the 4 <u>technique</u> of making lacquer ware from real craftsmen.
- 4. In fact, roadside stations offer numerous hands-on experiences such as rice harvesting, soba noodle making, and even rock climbing. Driving a train is the highlight of the roadside station in Rikubetsu Town, Hokkaido. With reservations, visitors can even drive a 1.6 km of track. It can be reserved as a package that includes hotel stay.
- 5. Local specialties, such as dishes made using seasonal fruits, vegetables or seafood, are behind the popularity of many roadside stations. Previously, many local dishes were only known locally, but now because of roadside stations, some have become ⑤ incredibly well-known through the Internet. People have even made orders for goods from other parts of the country.
