¹ All through history, nature has inspired humans to create. Did you know that Leonardo da Vinci's idea for a machine that flies came from seeing the wings of bats? You can see human inspiration that came from nature in building designs, clothing and other things we use every day. The (i) <u>field</u> of biomimetics tries to solve human problems by copying designs found in nature.

² One example comes from a plant called burdock that has seeds with sharp points. George de Mestral, a Swiss engineer, came home from a walk in the countryside and found that some seeds had attached to the hair on his dog and to his pants. He studied the seeds closely because he wanted to know the reason they stayed on so well. That's when he found extremely small hooks on them that easily attach to hair or clothing. This is how he (ii) <u>developed</u> the product known in Japan as "magic tape."

³ Biomimetics can also solve transportation problems. The (iii) <u>original</u> bullet trains in Japan had round front ends, but the shape produced a loud noise when entering tunnels. After many people complained, designers worked hard to reduce that loud noise.

⁴ Later, while watching birds called kingfishers dive into the water for fish, a designer wondered what would happen if the nose of the bullet train was very long, like a beak of a bird. Because of their long beaks, kingfishers can (iv) <u>penetrate</u> the water surface easily. In the same way, the new long-nose design of the bullet train went through the air more easily and made less noise.

⁵ It may seem like humans are becoming less (v) <u>connected</u> to nature as we develop technology. However, these designs show us how nature actually helps human technology get better.

- 1. Breakfast and dinner are served in the restaurant on the first floor. However, if you prefer, you can have your meals in your room. Please note: an additional \$20 fee will be added to your bill every time you use room service.
- 2. The bar and disco are open from 9:00 pm to 2:00 am. You will have a great time dancing and drinking there, but remember that the people in the rooms on the fifth floor might be able to hear you, so please be quiet.
- 3. Room numbers with a 1 on the end are for one guest, room numbers with a 2 at the end are for two guests, and rooms with a 3 on the end are suites for three or more guests. You cannot stay in a room with fewer beds than the number of guests, but you can stay in a bigger room if you pay an extra \$50 per night.
