Our group decided that we will make pancakes at the school festival.

You and I were asked to buy the ingredients for the pancakes. We need to decide when to go shopping for our pancake ingredients. How would this Sunday afternoon be? As you know, I have my part-time job on the day before.

Since I had a package of pancake mix at home, I looked at the package to see what we should buy. I put the information we need below.

We are planning to make enough pancakes for 300 people. We hope we can sell that many.

Each bag of pancake mix has four packages in it. To make each package of pancakes, we need 100ml of milk and one medium egg and there are 10 eggs in each carton. We will make four pancakes from each package. We will sell two pancakes to each person who wants them. So, we will need at least 38 bags of mix.

However, there are always accidents, so we may need some extra. We should also buy two extra bags of pancake mix, an extra liter of milk, and an extra carton of ten eggs. We can eat whatever is left over.

We will also need to buy strawberries and syrup. Each pair of pancakes will have three strawberries and 10ml of syrup. There are 15 strawberries in each package. We can buy just one extra package of strawberries. We might need to get the paper plates also, if the others can't find them in their local shop.

Please tell me what time and where we should meet this weekend.
